What if you called for help and no one came?

Spencer has a population of roughly 12,000 people. Out of the 12,000 there are only 40 Call/Volunteer Firefighters. Call/Volunteer Firefighters are declining nationwide. The Spencer Fire Department is struggling to keep the department properly staffed, leaving the community at risk! The community needs you!

What does it mean to be a Call/Volunteer department?

A call department means that firefighters are only at the station if they are dispatched to an incident. The only person at the station who is full time is the fire chief. Most of our department members work fulltime jobs and come from every walk of life, including electricians, plumbers, builders, farmers, EMTs, engineers, and stay at home moms.
